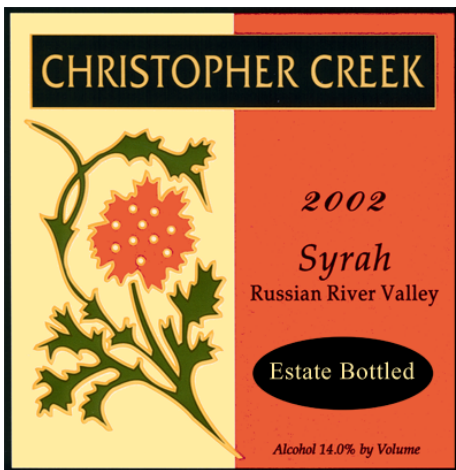

2002 Russian River Estate Bottled Syrah



At Christopher Creek we take special care in the management of our vineyards, and as always we hand-pick, hand-sort and hand-macerate our fruit to produce a distinct wine from “our” edge of the Russian River Valley! The 2002 Estate Bottled Syrah is no exception.

Produced from grapes grown at the winery site, our 2002 Estate Bottled Syrah displays black plum and black cherry with tastes of cocoa, spice, minerals and subtle smoky notes. On the palate, the texture is smooth and ample with a very long complex finish created by the rich, yet soft tannins. We would recommend bottle aging this wine for at least a year before drinking to let the tannins soften and the fruit fully develop. We would expect this wine to age well for 5-7 years.

Try our Syrah with Barbecued, marinated tri-tip roast, game, lamb, beef stew or spicy food. Syrah is also a great food companion to chocolate.
