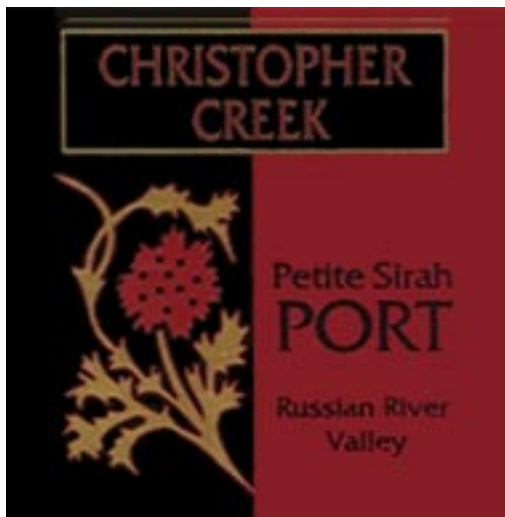




2007 Petite Sirah Port



Produced from grapes grown on vines located on a young vineyard on the west-facing hillside above Christopher Creek, the 2004 Petite Sirah Port is a full bodied wine layered with blueberry/blackberry fruit with a hint of chocolate. The fruit was harvested in late October at the early stages of raising when the rich, dark berry characters develop. About three fourths

of the way through fermentation, the wine is "knocked" with aged Germain-Robin brandy to halt the fermentation and preserve the residual grape sugar. A perfect wine for after dinner with cheese or chocolate or for sipping in front of the fire on a cold wintry evening.
